...a brief history



- 1913 - Vermilion School of Agriculture opens
- 1975 - Lakeland College is officially founded
- 1990 - Lloydminster campus officially opened

- 1997 - fire etc. becomes a subsidiary corporation of Lakeland College
- 2003 - Learning Centre opens in Sherwood Park and plans are announced to build a campus within a few years

- Members of the wider Lloydminster and Vermilion communities



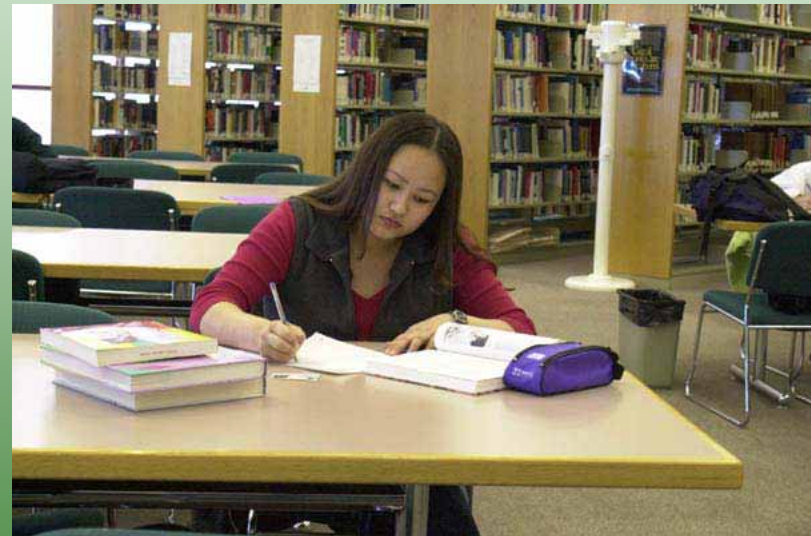
Courses

 - University Transfer



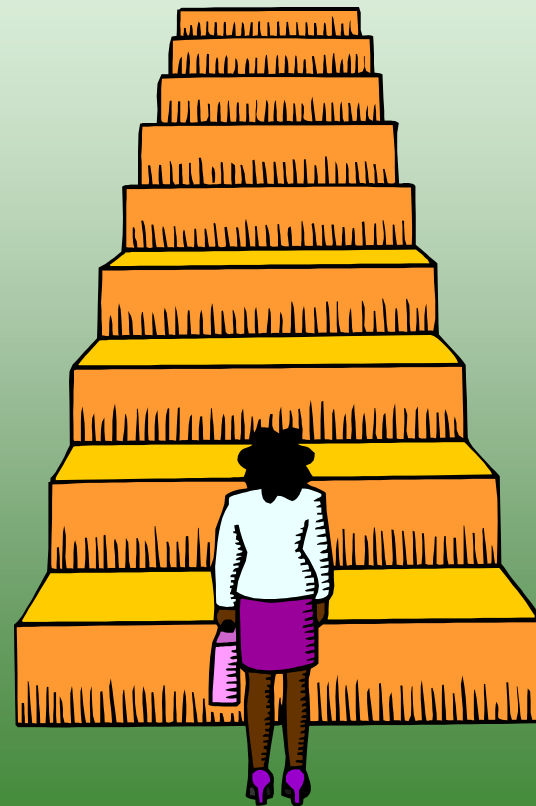
Lakeland College Library ...welcome!

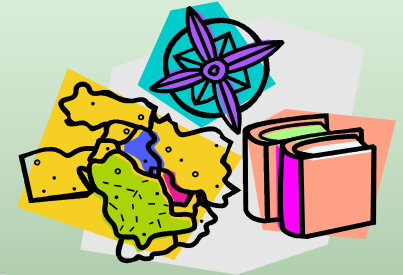
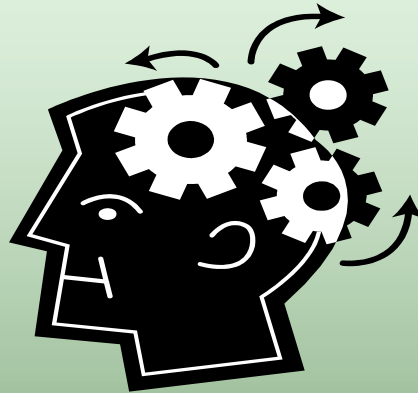

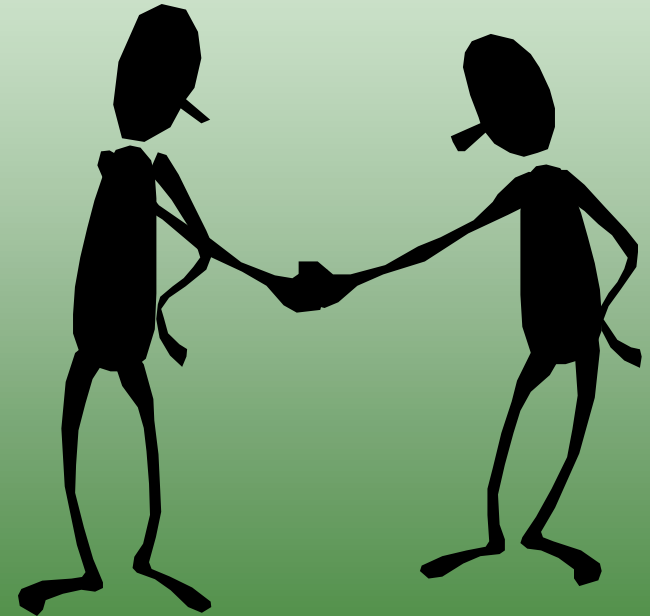


Collection development strategies

- Collection development overseen by one person (with input from all)
- Aim for minimal duplication across campuses
- Close relationship between Library and Faculty
- Increasing emphasis on e-journals, decreasing on print

- Smoother transition for students transferring to other post-secondary NEOS member institutes
- Greater negotiating power for access to e-resources
