
Cards will be collected and placed in frequently checked out library books at MacEwan to be found as a surprise!



Getting the cards to the students!

- Only in reserve items initially
- Expanded to include all regular loans as well
- Who knows? NEOS & TAL patrons might find these notes too!

Feedback so far

- "It made my day!" (student to library staff member)
- "Great idea", "Cool!", "Student first approach" (Wellness and Psychological Services Faculty)
- "I enjoy both writing messages and receiving messages" (Student)

What's next for the MacEwan Kindness Project?

- 816 note cards printed so far 700+ notes distributed since January!
- Partner with other MacEwan groups Student Residence, SAMU (Students' Association), and MacEwan International to have a university-wide Kindness initiative.
- Ask students in the Bachelor of Design program to create the note cards.
- Approach MacEwan Early Learning (daycare) for collaboration on design or simply asking the children to draw a picture on the Kindness cards
